RESOLVED, DECREED, AND ORDERED:

That the following named street shown on a shaded area on the accompanying plan entitled, "Providence, Rhode Island, Department of Public Works - Engineering Office, Street Line Section, Plan No. 063838 dated January 15, 1975,"

viz:

That portion of Charles Street from Smith Street to Mill Street, depicted on the accompanying plan as Cross Hatched Area (A-B-C-M-D-E-F-J-K-L-A) (having ceased to be useful to the public and the same is proposed to be abandoned as a public highway and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded,) subject to such easements as shall be required by the Department of Public Works in accordance with the accompanying said plan; the compliance with the request of the Water Supply Board incorporated in accompanying communication dated November 12, 1975 and further to access for Narragansett Electric Company within the full City easment as is incorporated on the said accompanying plan, and it is further

(ORDERED, that the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, that after the entry of this order or decree, the City Clerk shall cause a notice, thereof, to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks, and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within this State.)




Dear Mr. Vespia:


Dear Councilman Flynn:

On November 12, 1975 this department received a memorandum from the City Clerk relative to the abandonment of Charles Street between Smith Street and Mill Street.

The Water Supply Board has a 10-inch cast iron main in the above section of street. Previously, the Redevelopment Agency in one phase of its program replaced this main in another location. However, they have not completed the removal of the old 10-inch main. This latter main is still connected to the active 16-inch main in Smith Street.

We request that the Redevelopment Agency complete the abandonment of the 10-inch main in referenced section of Charles Street by plugging the cast iron tee in Smith Street before the street is abandoned. This would be the best procedure from an engineering and economical view point. A less desirable alternate would be to cut and cap the 10-inch main on the project limit at the north side of Smith Street.

Gentlemen:

This petition from the Committee on Public Works presents a proposal by the Providence Redevelopment Agency for the abandonment of that portion of Charles St. which lies between Smith St. on the south and the intersection of Mill St. on the north. The abandonment would be subject to the granting of easements for sewer and electric lines beneath the property. This would preclude future excavation of, or construction over, the property. The land on both sides of the proposed abandonment is owned by the Providence Redevelopment Agency.

This proposal is part of a plan for the use and disposal of PRA land in the area and has been researched by the staff and approved by the PRA.


No objection is offered by this department to the proposed abandonment as described in the petition.
