



Biographical Sketch

Sanford H. Gorodetsky was born at Providence, R. I. and educated in Providence public schools, Classical High School, and then served in the United States Army and was discharged in 1947; then he went on to Providence College for undergraduate work and was graduated from Boston University School of Law in 1953. He was admitted to the Bar of the State of Rhode Island in 1954 and practiced law continuously thereafter. He has been an officer and a member of many associations and clubs and has been involved in many community activities.

He has served as a member of the Providence City Council and was a Chief Judge of the Municipal Court of Providence and presently serves as Chairman of the Mayor's Crime Commission and is a member of the Governor's Justice Commission and a member of the State Advisory and Coordinating Committee on Alcoholism. He has been an instructor at Bryant College in law and law enforcement subjects since 1966.

He was named to the position of Commissioner of Public Safety on July 9, 1979.

He is a member of the International Association of Chiefs of Police and the International Association of Fire Chiefs and the American Bar Association and Rhode Island Bar Association, and many other organizations.
