No. 275 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION
ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1350 BY ADDING THE SUM OF SEVENTY-FIVE
THOUSAND (\$75,000) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION FOR SEWAGE
DISPOSAL SECTION, ITEM 2.

Approved April 21, 1961

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1350 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 16, 1960, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$40,869,634.16 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1961", as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the sum of Seventy-Five Thousand (\$75,000) Dollars to the appropriation for SEWAGE DISPOSAL SECTION, ITEM 2.

SECTION 2. The said sum of Seventy-Five Thousand (\$75,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3. The estimated receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by Seventy-Five Thousand (\$75,000) Dollars.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.



SECTION 1. Chapter 1350 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 16, 1960, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$40,869,634.16 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1961", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000) Dollars to PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT-SNOW REMOVAL SECTION, ITEM O.

SECTION 2. The said sum of One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by increasing the estimated receipts from:



No. 277 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11 of CHAPTER 1351,

"ESTABLISHING THE CLASSES OF POSITIONS, THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES AND THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES IN CERTAIN CLASSES IN THE CITY DEPARTMENTS", AS APPROVED SEPTEMBER 16, 1960.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1351 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence approved September 16, 1960, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

SECTION 11: TABULATING DIVISION

That part which has heretofore read: "The number of employees in the TABULATING DIVISION shall not exceed eight (8)"; shall hereafter read: "The number of employees in the TABULATING DIVISION shall not exceed nine (9)".

Add: 1 Tabulating Equipment Operator



Dear Sir:

Referring to the Docket of the City Council for April 20, 1961, authorizing Hyman Sherman and Martha Sherman to erect light poles on Assessor's Plat 88, Lot 102, on Elmwood Avenue, please be advised that this Department has made an inspection and we find that the steel poles have been erected for the purpose of supporting flood lights for a proposed automobile sales lot. The height of the poles are 29' above ground and 6' below ground, and they are 5½" in diameter. The arms which will support the lights extend about 7' over the sidewalk.

The poles are structurally safe and, therefore, are approved by this Department.






