WHEREAS, on Saturday, May 1, 1976 and Sunday, May 2, 1976, during the hours 10:00 o'clock A.M. and 5:00 o'clock P.M., the Painting Club of the Rhode Island School of Design will conduct its annual exhibition on the same section of Benefit Street and accordingly, respectfully request it be closed to motor vehicle traffic,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause Benefit Street, between Waterman Street and College Street, to be closed to motor vehicle traffic on Saturday, April 24, 1976, between 12:00 o'clock M. and 4:00 o'clock P.M. on Saturday, May 1 and Sunday, May 2, 1976, between 10:00 o'clock A.M. and 5:00 o'clock P.M. for the Rhode Island School of Design Parent's Day Program.
