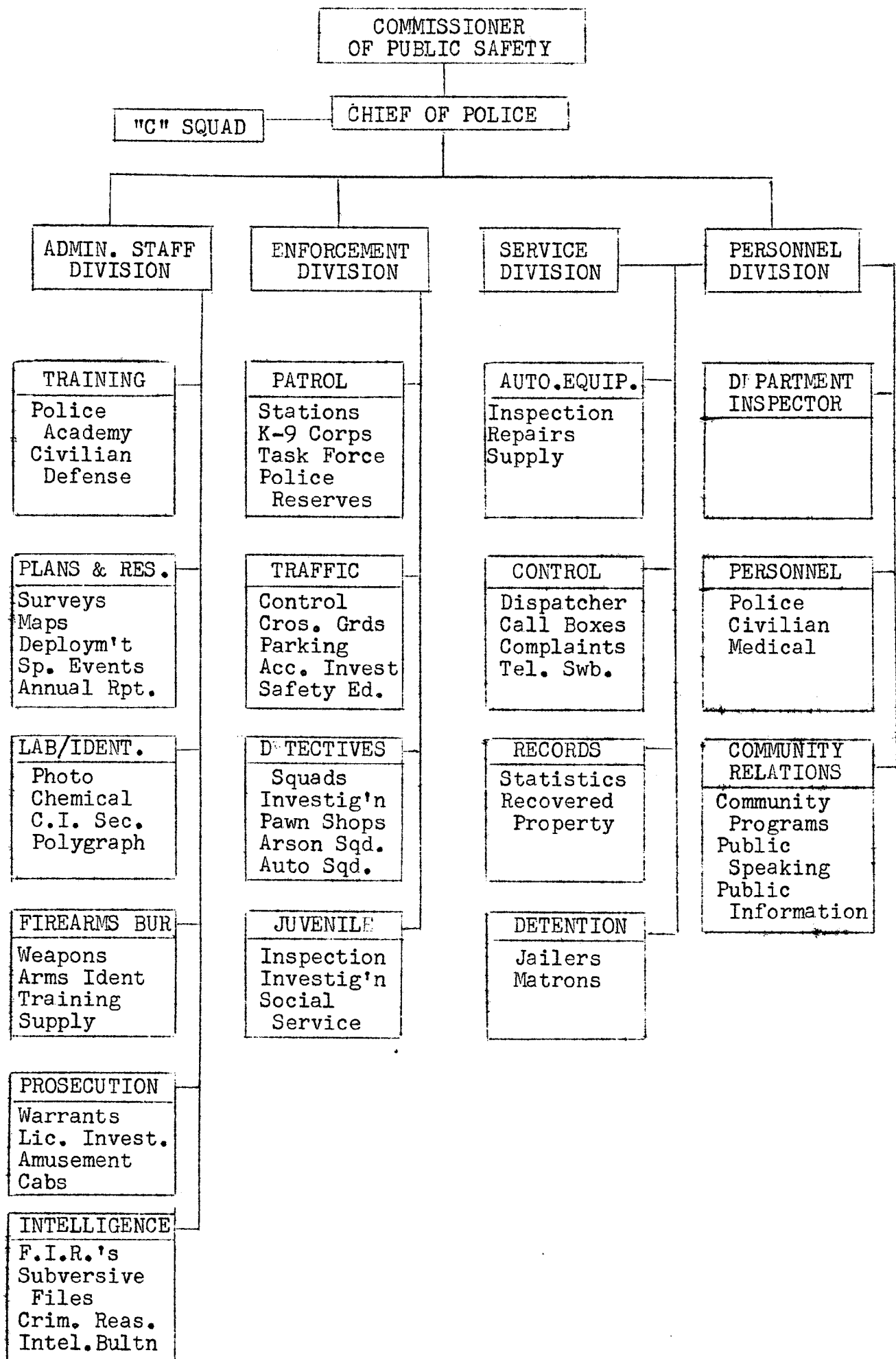

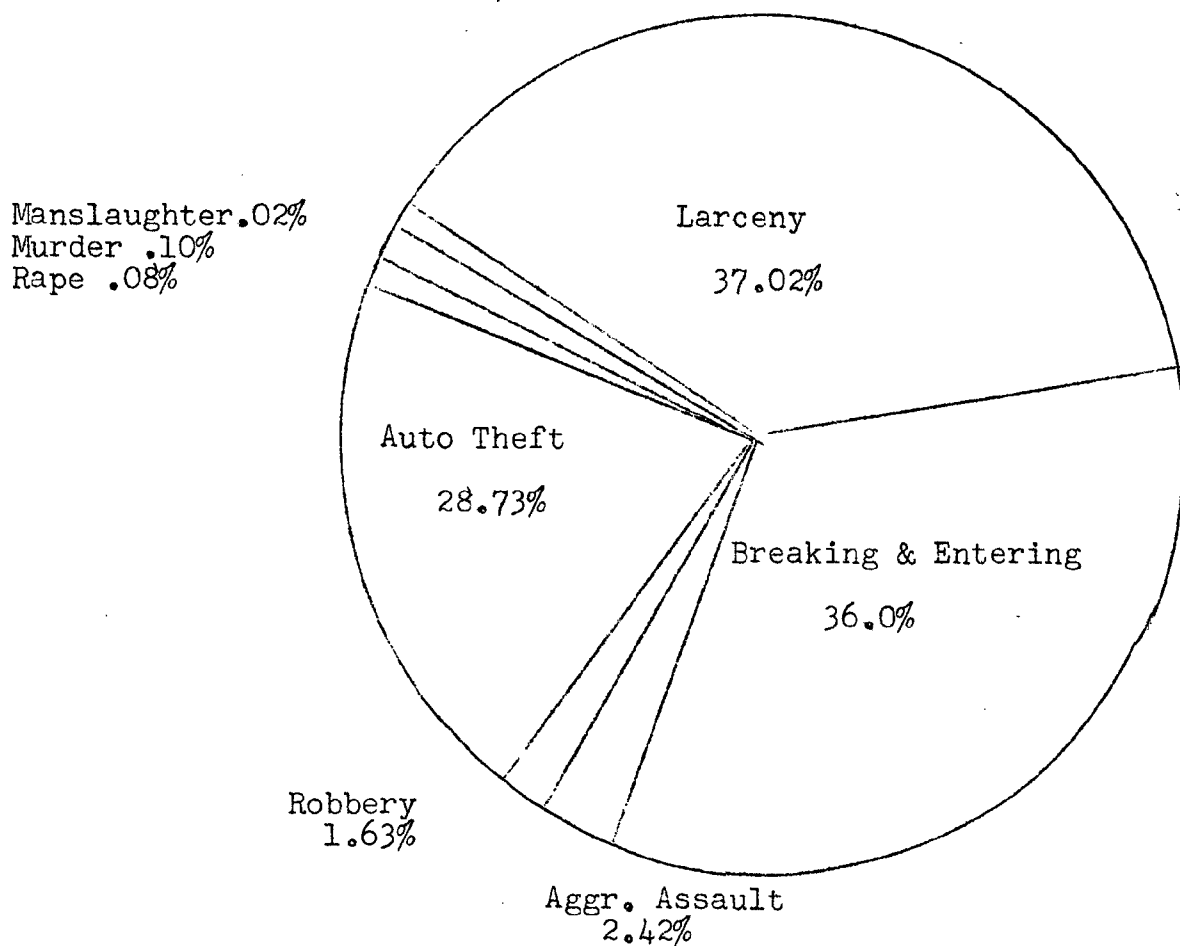

UNIFORM CRIME CLASSIFICATION

The most predominant category of Part I crimes occurring in the city of Providence during 1967 was Larceny which occurred at the rate of 11+ offenses per day. There were 60.5 Part I offenses per 1000 Population which occurred at the rate of one offense every 46.4 minutes.

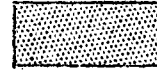

CLEARANCE OF PART I OFFENSES REPORTED TO THE POLICE

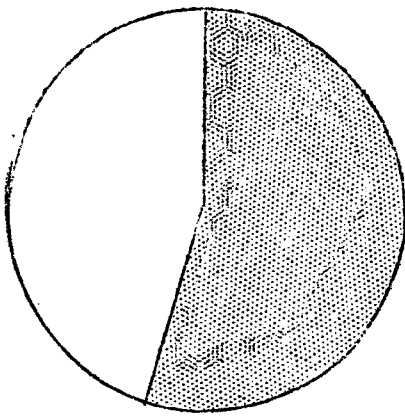

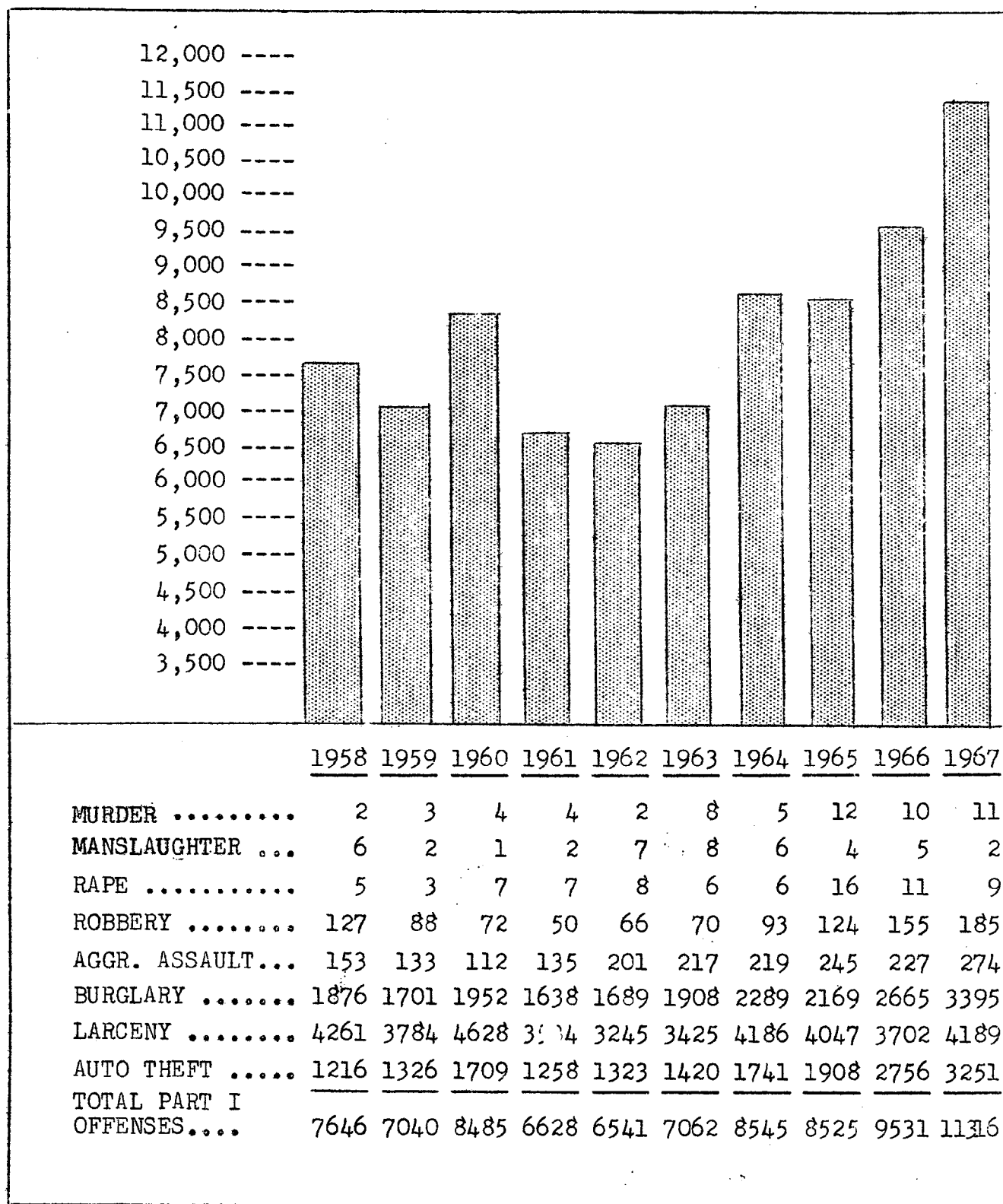

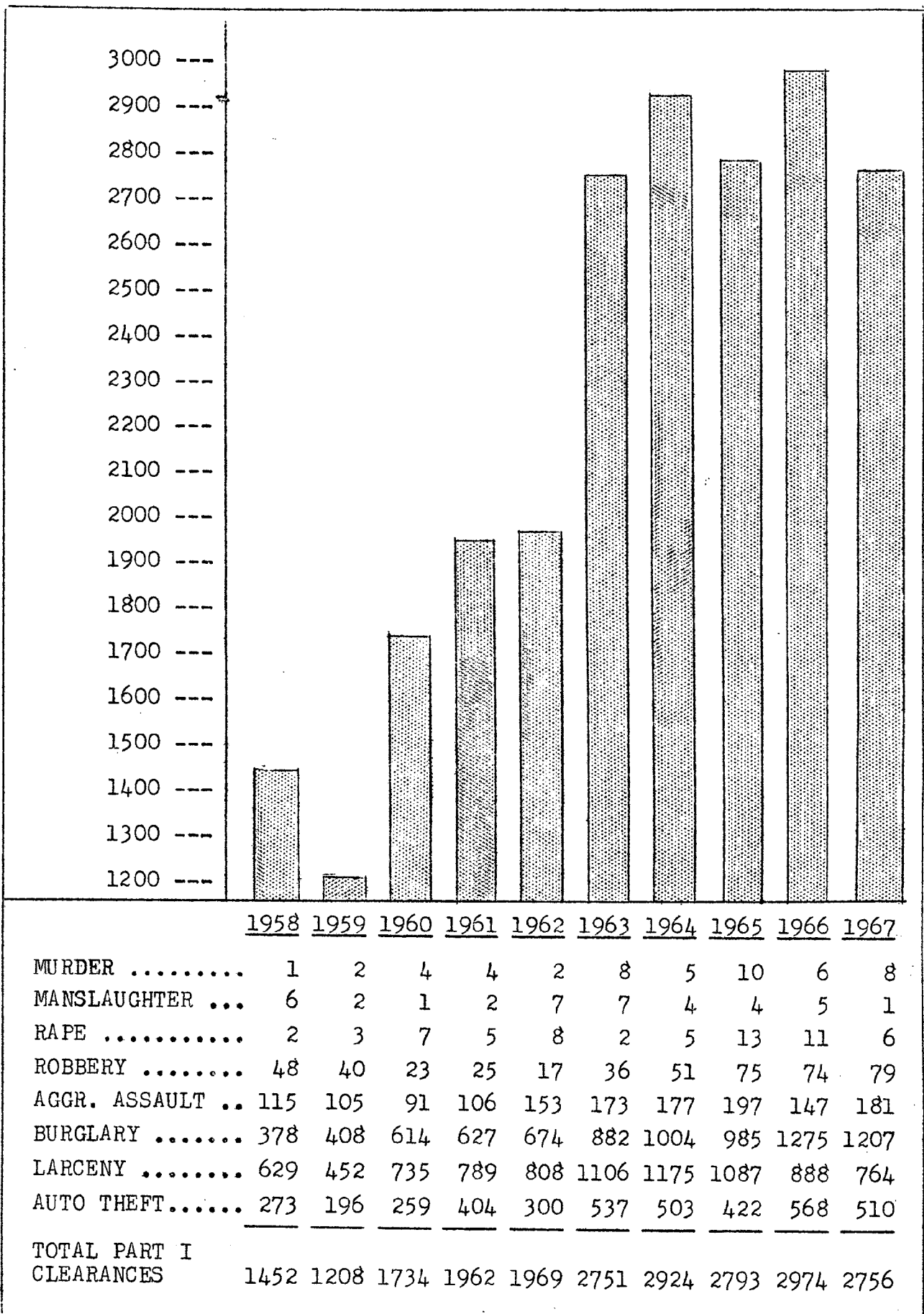

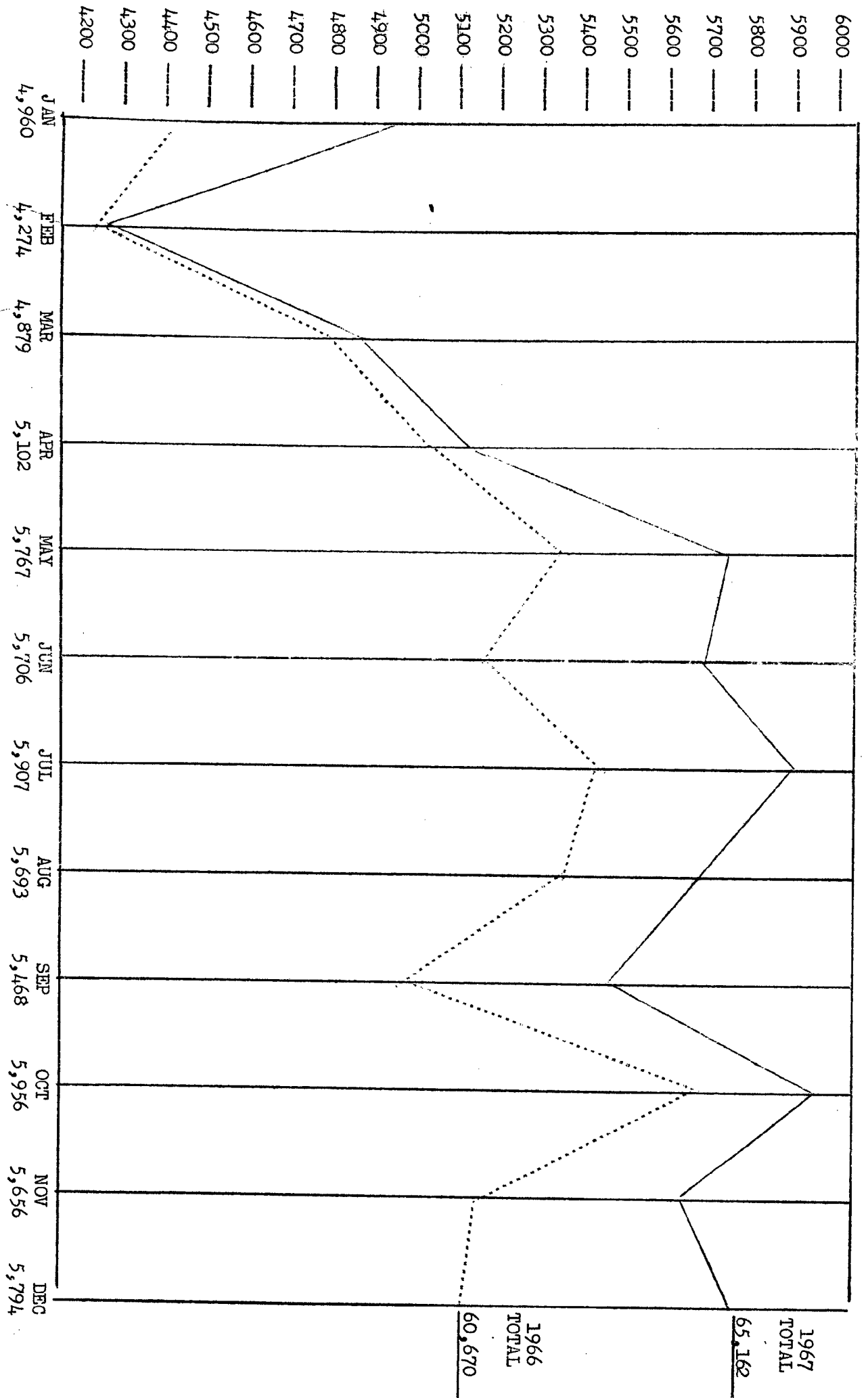
PART I OFFENSES 1958 - 1967

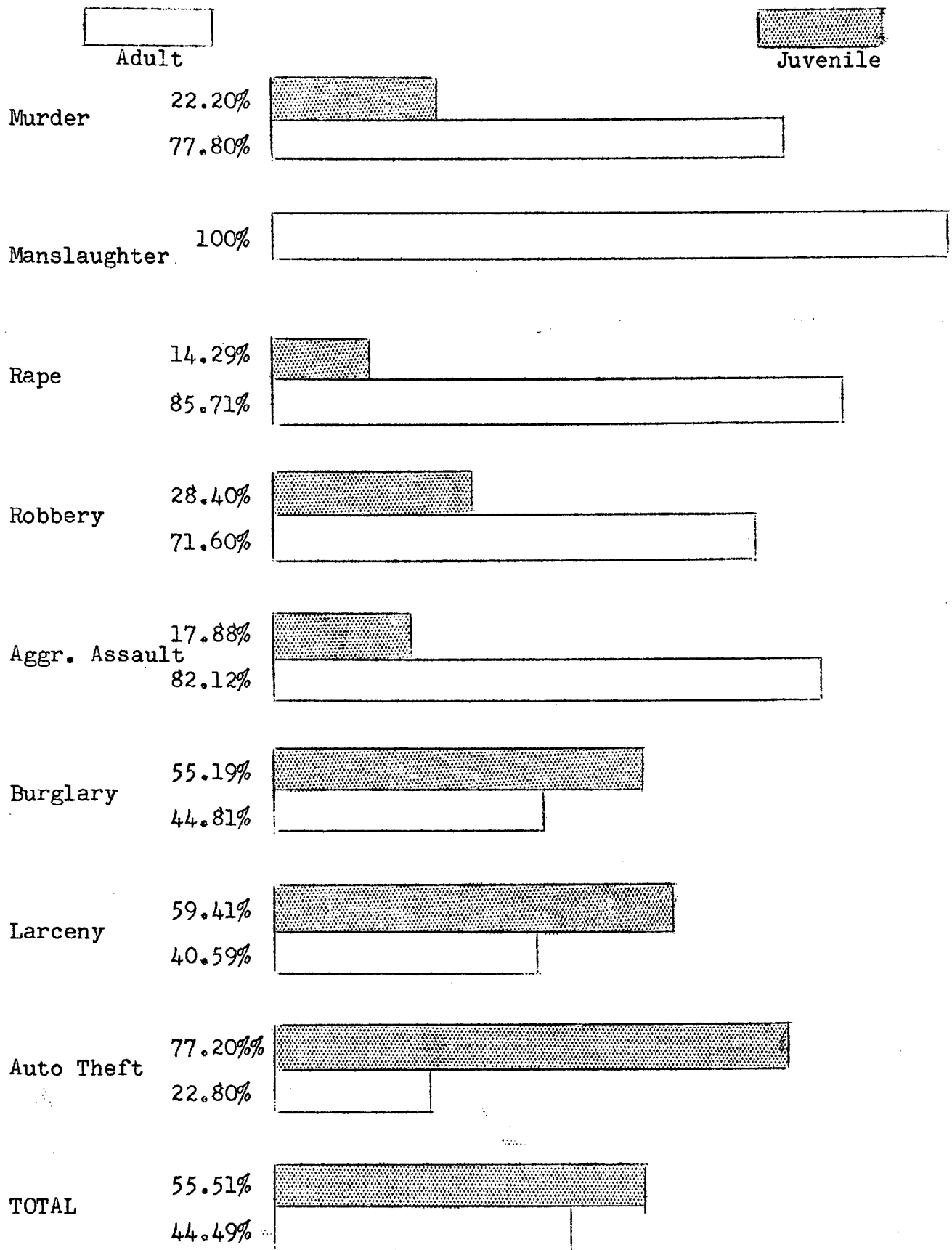

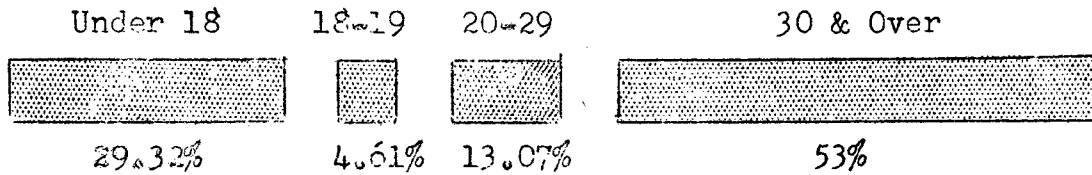
ADULT-JUVENILE ARRESTS FOR PART I OFFENSES IN PROVIDENCE IN 1967



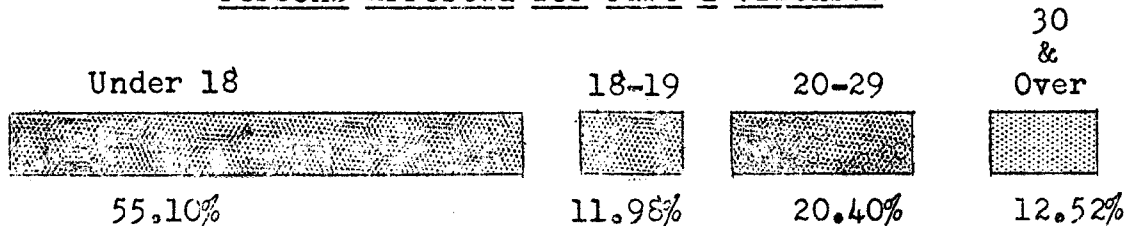
COMPARISON OF POPULATION AGE GROUPS TO ARREST AGE GROUPS

"Special Census of Rhode Island, October, 1965"

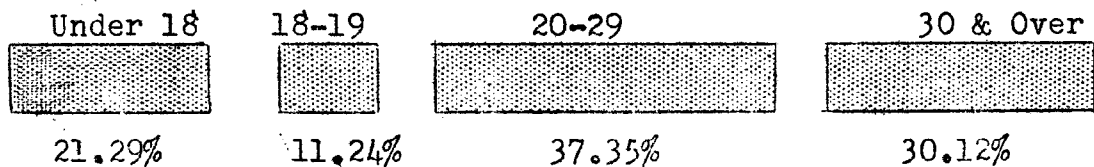
Providence Population by Age Group



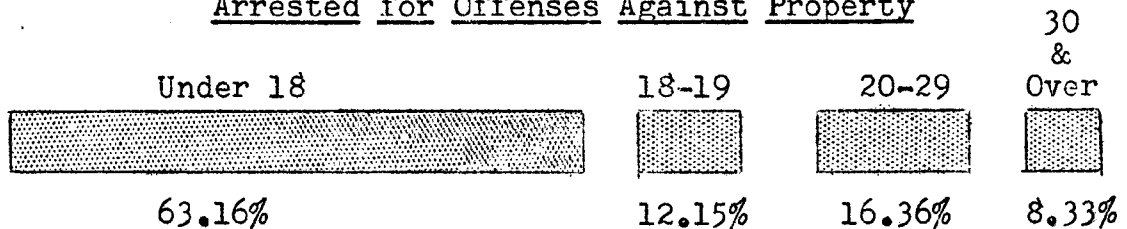
Persons Arrested for Part I Offenses
