
There are a couple of buildings on Willow Street which are of concern to the Revolving Fund and the neighborhood.

One is 32 Willow which had a severe fire 18 months ago. The building is owned by Dean Street Associates. It has been without a roof since the fire and continues to pose a health and safety threat to the immediate neighbors. Since the owners have shown no initiative in repairing the structure, I believe that the City should move to demolish it immediately.

The second concern is with a building at 57 Willow Street which is presently being renovated. This 2½ story dwelling is zoned for 2 units, though four meters have been installed. There is not adequate parking, square footage (the lot is only 2,136 sq. ft.), or sufficient ceiling height going up the stairs to the third floor. Work should be stopped on this project.

I hope you will act on these issues.
