No. 475 AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 1977-25 APPROVED JUNE 8, 1977, ESTABLISHING THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF FELINES THAT MAY BE KEPT BY THE OWNER OR OCCUPANT OF A DWELLING HOUSE.

Approved May 22, 1979

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1977-25 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved June 8, 1977, is hereby amended as follows;

"Sec. 4-37.2. That no owner or occupant of any dwelling house shall keep or permit to be kept more than three (3) felines in any part of any dwelling house except if said owner or occupant complies with Sec. 4-13-10 of the Rhode Island General Laws, 1956, as amended."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by the City Council and approved by the Mayor.
