



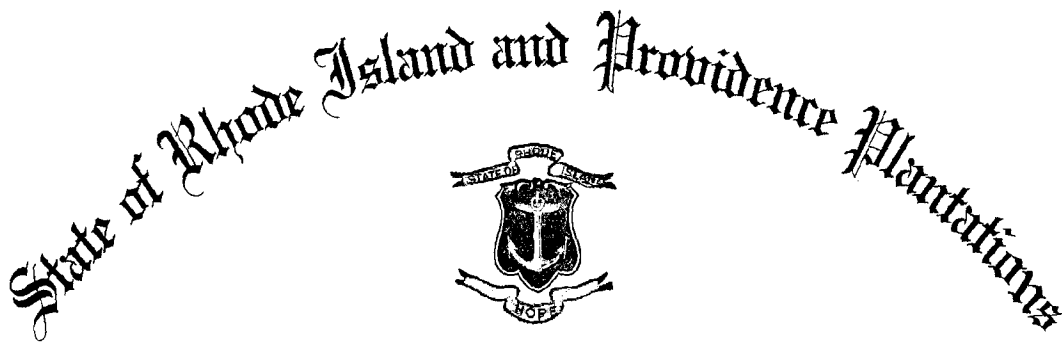

HOUSE *Resolution*

RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE PROVIDENCE HOUSING AUTHORITY TO NAME THE HOUSING FACILITY, NOW BEING ERECTED ON SMITH STREET BETWEEN COMMON STREET AND WINDSOR STREET, "ARARAT MANOR"

Whereas, Seven hundred and fifty parishioners and friends of Sts. Sahag and Mesrob Armenian Apostolic Church in the city of Providence petitioned the Providence City Council to recommend to the Housing Authority of Providence that it name the housing facility now being erected on Smith street between Common street and Windsor street in honor of the Armenian citizenry of Providence, and

Whereas, It is the prayer of these same parishioners and friends that the said housing facility which is in an area within which reside many Americans of Armenian extraction who have contributed much to the cultural, social, economic and religious life of the city of Providence and to the state of Rhode Island and accordingly, are most desirous of having a monument in recognition of that contribution; and

Whereas, the Honorable City Council of Providence and Mayor Joseph Doorley unanimously approved on October 30, 1972 a resolution recommending that the Housing Authority of Providence designate the aforementioned housing facility "Ararat Manor" which is symbolic of Armenia and the landing site of Noah's Ark as recorded in Biblical history; and

Whereas, In 1973 Sts. Sahag and Mesrob Armenian Church will celebrate its 60th anniversary; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the house of representatives of the state of

Rhode Island strongly endorses the recommendation of the seven hundred and fifty citizens, the Mayor of Providence and the Providence City Council to name the housing facility on Smith street "Ararat Manor"; and be it further

Resolved, that the secretary of state be and he hereby is authorized and directed to transmit duly certified copies of this resolution to the Providence Housing Authority, the Providence City Council and to Sts. Sahag and Mesrob Armenian Church.
