That part which has heretofore read: "The number of employees in the Police Department shall not exceed seven hundred twenty-one (721)"; shall hereafter read: "The number of employees in the Police Department shall not exceed seven hundred twenty-two (722)".

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Resolved,

**That** the City Treasurer, acting under the direction of the Committee on Finance, be and he hereby is authorized and directed to borrow from time to time such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding Four Million Six Hundred Thousand (\$4,600,000) Dollars, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 109 of the Public Laws, passed by the General Assembly at its January Session, A. D. 1959 and approved May 28, 1959, entitled "An Act Authorizing the City of Providence to Issue Bonds in the sum of FOUR MILLION SIX HUNDRED (\$4,600,000) DOLLARS for a Hurricane Barrier", and to issue the City's notes therefor, bearing interest at a rate not exceeding three and one-half (3½%) per cent per annum, signed by him, and countersigned by the Mayor and Chairman of the Finance Committee; and to renew any such notes from time to time as the same become due. The money thus obtained is hereby appropriated for and shall be used and expended for the construction of a hurricane barrier in the City of Providence including the acquisition of any land, water rights, easements and other property interests necessary or desirable for that purpose.
