AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING GAMING OR BETTING IN A PUBLIC CONVEYANCE OR PUBLIC PLACE OR WHILE TRESPASSING IN PRIVATE PLACE

Approved April 22, 1983

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Whoever, in a public conveyance or public place, or in a private place upon which he or she is trespassing, participates in games of chance, including but not limited to cards or dice, for money or other property, or places bets or wagers upon the outcome of such games, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days or both.

Whoever, shall conduct or allow or suffer such a game to be conducted upon his or her property shall be subject to a fine of not more than Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars or imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days, or both.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
