WHEREAS, This lifetime of service to others has well prepared Balbina for her duties as Councilwoman from the Eleventh Ward,

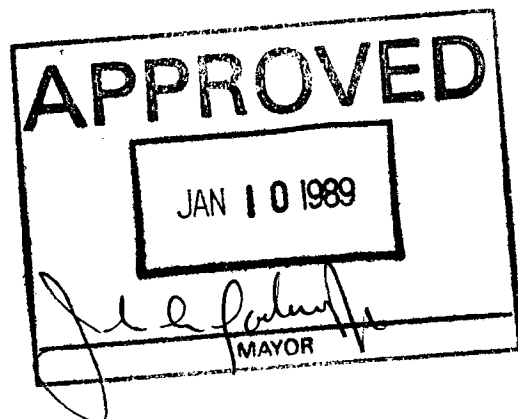
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the members of the City Council welcome our newest colleague, and extend their best wishes for a long and successful career.
