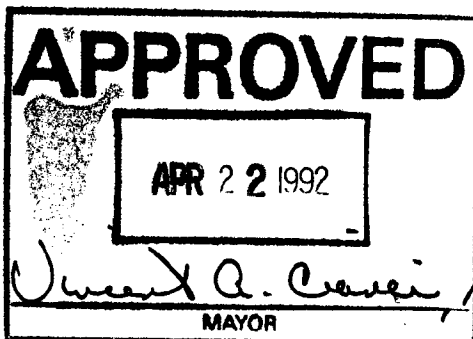

Dear Councilman Dillon:

I am writing to request that the Finance Committee take action to amend the pay ordinance approved last November as part of the Department's reorganization program.


The ordinance incorrectly established salaries for the following three positions:

- * Assistant Director for Housing Development at \$35,000
- * Assistant Director for Planning at \$30,000
- * Real Estate Aide at \$20,000.

The corrections we are requesting be made appear on the attached amended ordinance drafted at the Department of Planning and Development for submission. What makes this particularly problematic is that two of the three positions listed above have been filled -- the Assistant Director for Housing Development at \$40,000; and Real Estate Aide for \$25,000. Both employees began working last week. The third position, Assistant Director for Planning has not yet been filled, but interviews have been conducted and qualified applicants have been told that the position will offer \$40,000 in compensation.

I regret any inconvenience caused as a result of this Department's failure to identify this error earlier. I thank you for your assistance in helping us resolve this problem, and I am prepared to meet with the Finance Committee to answer any questions.
