





SUBJECT: Resolution requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause Berkshire Street to be established as a "One-Way" Street in a northeasterly direction from June Street to Clym Street.

The DPW - Traffic Engineering Division agrees with the decision to cause Berkshire Street to be established as a "One-Way" Street in a northeasterly direction from June Street to Clym Street. Traffic Regulation # 9-636 was created on March 16, 2009 to fulfill this request. The signs to implement this new One-Way traffic pattern have not been installed as of April 27, 2009 due to the public advertising requirement.
