

I am writing to request that the following requested contract awards be submitted to the City Council and the Finance Committee for approval:

- **Providence Water:**
 - Award Cleaning and Lining Water Mains (Blackstone) to **W. Walsh Company, Inc**, second lowest bidder, for an amount not to exceed **\$9,541,340.00** over two years in accordance with the Code of Ordinance, Section 21-26 (a);
 - Award Cleaning and Lining Water Mains (Edgewood) to **Biszko Contracting Corp**, low bidder, for an amount not to exceed **\$4,433,480.00** over two years in accordance with the Code of Ordinance, Section 21-26 (a);
 - Award Cleaning and Lining Water Mains (Marievillle) to **Biszko Contracting Corp**, low bidder, for an amount not to exceed **\$5,610,675.00** over two years in accordance with the Code of Ordinance, Section 21-26 (a);
 - Award Replacement and Rehabilitation of Water Mains Appurtenances with Providence's Water Distribution System (Blanket Contract) with **multiple vendors**, for an amount not to exceed **\$10,000,000** over three years in accordance with the Code of Ordinance, Section 21-26 (a);

 - Approval of the ratification of an award with **Cross Insurance, Inc** in the amount of **\$53,037.00** in accordance with the Code of Ordinance, Section 21-26 (b);


