Approved March 17, 1978

WHEREAS, It has been ascertained that many children are being molested on their way to and from their respective schools and that protection is necessary for their safety, and

WHEREAS, Numerous incidents of children being abducted and being physically abused in various manners, have been reported which is alarming to the students and to their parents,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police is requested to assign Police Patrols in the areas of the Providence Public Schools during the hours of 7:45 o'clock A.M. and 8:30 o'clock A.M. and from 2:00 o'clock P.M. to 2:45 o'clock P.M. and when the said schools have special occasions, Police Patrols be effected in the interest of the safety of our children.
