
I have forwarded the Resolution to the Rhode Island Public Transit Authority for investigation and consideration.

Dear Ms. Angelone:

The Department of Health is in receipt of a "Resolution of the City Council" requesting a safety compliance inspection at Murray Auto Body, Inc. As I discussed with you in today's phone conversation, the Department of Health does not have compliance authority with respect to workplace safety hazards in private sector businesses.

I suggested that the concerned member of the City Council contact the U.S. Department of Labor, Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), which does have enforcement authority to conduct safety inspections in private workplaces. OSHA's Providence area office can be reached at 528-4669. While OSHA can investigate complaints from employees or other concerned parties, they do request information on the nature of the complaint. They will keep the identity of the person confidential and will provide them with information on the findings of their investigation.


