

Gentlemen:

The following proposed resolutions have been reviewed by this department and has made the following dispositions:

Request: That Anthony Avenue be established as a one way street.

Disposition: Denied. The majority of the residents of Anthony Avenue do not want the street made one way.

Request: That the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause the installation of four-way STOP signs at the intersection of Ivy Street and Dana Street.

Disposition: Denied. There are no traffic warrants to justify the installation of a four-way stop control at this time.

✓ Request: That O'Neil Street be made a one way street, from Veazie Street to Douglas Avenue in a southerly direction.

Disposition: Denied. O'Neil Street serves as a connector between Douglas Avenue and Branch Avenue. In addition, the speeding problem that already exists on O'Neil Street would be greatly increased.
