



Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, September 9, 1958.

This referral is a request for a change of zoning from an R-3 Zone to an M-1 Zone Lot 308 on Assessor's Plat 110 located at 644 Union Avenue.


On the field trip it was found that the area in question is occupied by a two-story building now being used for club purposes. The surrounding area is predominantly residential.

The granting of this petition would create an industrial use in a residential zone, creating a new case of spot zoning which would adversely affect the immediate adjoining and surrounding properties. The City of Providence is at present undertaking an Urban Renewal Program in this area, through application of the Minimum Housing Standards. The proposed change would make it more difficult of accomplishment if this petition were granted. Therefore,

Dear Madam:

At a special meeting of the Zoning Board of Review held on Wednesday, September 24, 1958, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, Giuseppina Stero, owner of Lots 506 and 507 on Assessor's Plat 63 (344 Manton Avenue) in a Residence R-4 Zone, on August 22, 1958, filed an application to install three additional 3,000 gallon underground gasoline storage tanks and erect one additional gasoline pump making a total underground storage of 12,000 gallons of petroleum products and three fuel pumps on the above described premises and to move the existing sign to a new corner location, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on this application by the Zoning Board of Review at its meeting held on Tuesday, September 16, 1958, after public notice as provided by the Zoning Ordinance,

RESOLVED: That the Zoning Board of Review does hereby make a variation of the use district regulations under the Zoning Ordinance and does hereby grant the application of Giuseppina Stero substantially in accordance with the plans and plot plan filed with said Board, on condition that there shall be no overnight parking of vehicles on the premises and that the business be conducted between the hours of 7:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M. and on further condition that a buffer strip of planted hedges be maintained along the southwesterly and southeasterly lines of Lot number 506. A copy of said plans and plot plan are hereby made a part of this resolution and filed with the Director of the Dept. of Building Inspection.
