

WHEREAS, There are no crosswalks painted along Academy Avenue, at its intersection with Smith Street which is unsafe for the students going to and from school, and


WHEREAS, It would be in the best interest of the City and safer for persons crossing the roadway to have a pedestrian crosswalk signal located at the intersection,


