RESOLVED THAT, His Honor the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to execute a deed to Michael J. Kelly and wife, Jane M. Kelly, of the City of Cranston, conveying that parcel of real estate hereinafter described, which is presently held by the City of Providence under trust created by the Will of the late Charles H. Smith, under two quitclaim deeds to the City of Providence--one dated May 16, 1947 from the President and Fellows of Harvard College, recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the City of Providence in deed book 919 at page 321, and the other dated May 16, 1947 from Daphne Eugenie Cameron, recorded in said records in deed book 919 at page 339. 
