RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 400

Approved June 10, 1965

RESOLVED, that the City Treasurer, acting under the direction of the Committee on Finance, be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to borrow from time to time such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding THIRTEEN MILLION (\$13,000,000) DOLLARS, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 46 of the Public Laws passed by the General Assembly at its January Session, A. D. 1965, and approved April 26, 1965, entitled "An Act Authorizing the City of Providence to Issue Bonds in the sum of Thirteen Million (\$13,000,000.) Dollars for the Construction of Major Improvements to the Water Supply System", and to issue the City's notes therefor, signed by him and countersigned by the Mayor and Chairman of Finance Committee; and to renew any such notes from time to time as the same become due. The money thus obtained is hereby appropriated for and shall be exclusively used and expended for the construction of major improvements to the Providence Water Supply System including a new tunnel and aqueduct, additional filters and incidental construction necessary in connection therewith.
