No. 621 **AN ORDINANCE** TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUE OF
\$2,500,000 SCHOOL FOR HANDICAPPED CHILDREN BONDS PURSUANT TO
CHAPTER 53 OF THE PUBLIC LAWS OF 1969 AS AMENDED.

Approved December 24, 1973

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. The sum of \$2,500,000 shall be borrowed for the purpose of acquiring land and constructing, equipping and furnishing a public school building to be used as a special education facility for handicapped children. The City Treasurer, with the approval of the Mayor and the Committee on Finance, is authorized to issue \$2,500,000 School for Handicapped Children Bonds pursuant to Chapter 53 of the Public Laws of 1969 as amended and, subject to the foregoing, to determine the denominations, interest rate or rates, and other terms, conditions and details of the bonds in accordance with law.

SECTION 2. The bonds shall be issued originally as coupon bonds in substantially the form approved by the City Council in Resolution No. 63, approved February 21, 1968. The bonds shall be sold at public sale at not less than par and accrued interest and shall bear such date or dates as the City Council shall determine by resolution and shall be payable in annual installments commencing not later than five years and ending not later than thirty years from their date or dates as the City Council shall determine by resolution.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all other ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
