NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the General Assembly is earnestly urged to pass an act substantially in accordance with the accompanying draft act, being "An Act in Amendment of Section 20-33-2 of the General Laws in Chapter 20-33, entitled "Fox Bounties", which would transfer from Town and City Clerks to game wardens, the duty of certification of foxes killed to secure a bounty; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk be authorized to confer with the Presiding Officer of the Rhode Island Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and such other members of the General Assembly as he may deem necessary, to cause the introduction of the accompanying draft of Act.

IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 20-33-2 OF THE GENERAL
LAWS IN CHAPTER 20-33 ENTITLED "FOX BOUNTIES."

SECTION 1. Section 20-33-2 of the general laws in chapter 20-33 entitled "Fox Bounties" is hereby amended to read as follows:

"20-33-2. Proof and payment of bounty. - Before such legal resident shall be entitled to receive the sum specified in section 20-33-1, he shall exhibit to a game warden of the department of natural resources at such time and place as shall be designated by the director of said department by regulation, the entire carcass of the fox and shall make affidavit of the time and place of such killing. The officer before whom such animal shall be exhibited shall thereupon cause the tongue to be removed from said carcass and, if satisfied that said affidavit is true, certify that the person making such affidavit exhibited to said officer the entire carcass of the fox alleged to have been killed and that said officer examined such carcass and found it intact with no portion of the tongue removed or mutilated, and that he, the said officer, caused the tongue to be removed from such carcass; said affidavit with certificate shall be forwarded to the chief of the division of fish and game of the department of natural resources and, upon the approval of said chief, such affidavit and certificate shall be sent to the controller, said forms for affidavits, certificates and approvals to be furnished to the game warden by the chief of said division of fish and game; and the controller shall, if said affidavit and certificate are in accordance with the provisions of this section and are presented within thirty (30) days after the time named in such affidavit, draw his order upon the general treasurer

in favor of the person signing such affidavit. The general assembly shall annually appropriate such sum as it may deem necessary for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this section and section 20-33-1."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

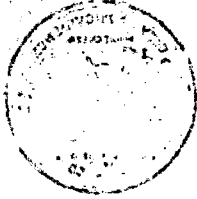

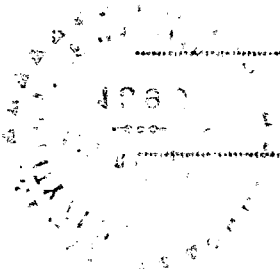

CHAPTER:

AN ACT

IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 3155 OF THE PUBLIC LAWS OF 1953 ENTITLED,
"AN ACT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL PAYMENTS TO RETIRED EMPLOYEES OF THE
CITY OF PROVIDENCE", APPROVED MAY 7, 1953.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. The city of Providence is hereby authorized to pay each retired employee of the city who has been retired either after twenty-five (25) years in the service of the city, or because of disability, an amount, which when added to all earned income received by such employee from any source whatsoever and also any retirement, pension or social security allowances, shall assure such employee a monthly income of an amount to be fixed by the city council or committee designated by it, but in no event more than two hundred (\$200) dollars per month.

SECTION 2. Any payment made by the city under the terms of this act shall be deemed a gratuity and not a matter of right. The city council may, in its discretion, revoke, suspend or alter any such payment.

SECTION 3. The city council shall appropriate from time to time from the general funds of the city such sums as may be necessary for the purposes of this act. Appropriations so made shall not be deducted from the funds of any existing pension or retirement system nor credited against any contributions or payments made or required to be made by the city to such pension system.

SECTION 4. Chapter 3155 of the Public Laws of 1953 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage.


