

This letter is in reply to your communication, dated February 3rd, 1956, concerning one Richard Frank Johnson of 301 Manton Avenue, Providence, R.I., who has made application for an Auctioneers License.

Richard Frank Johnson was born in Cranston, R.I. on July 21, 1916 and has lived in Providence for the past twenty years. He was educated in the Cranston School System and left school while in the tenth grade at the William Briggs School in that city. He has been employed at the Brown & Sharpe Mfg. Company as a grinder for the past twenty years. Previous to that, he was employed by the Shell Oil Company as a truckdriver.

Mr. Johnson served in the U.S. Army for one year and was honorably discharged. He has had an active interest in auctions for a number of years and now he intends to become an auctioneer. He has two children, ages seventeen and eighteen, and they live with their parents at the above address. He has lived at 301 Manton Avenue since 1941 and previous to that, resided at 54 Chaffee Street, Providence, R.I.
