





Gentlemen:

The Traffic Engineering Department has investigated the intersections of Ethan Street and Sophia Street, Ethan Street and Simmons Street, and Farmington Avenue and Plainfield Street.

Traffic volumes on all of these streets were found to be of a minor nature, and a breakdown of the accident experience is cited below:

<u>Intersection</u>	<u>Date</u>	<u>Accidents</u>
Ethan Street and Sophia Street	May 1, 1954 - May 1, 1957	1
Ethan Street and Simmons Street	May 1, 1954 - May 1, 1957	4
Farmington Avenue and Plainfield Street	May 1, 1954 - May 1, 1957	0

From the minor traffic volumes involved and the excellent accident records, it is felt that these intersections do not meet the minimum requirements for traffic control at this time.
