

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 466

Approved September 21, 1973

Whereas, during the past summer season, the City of Providence granted to several of its young citizens, the opportunity of seasonal employment under the E.E.A. - Section P.E.P. Employment Program, and

Whereas, that program proved most productive, in that it afforded those youthful government interns an insight of certain phases of the operations of the Municipal Government, while earning modest salaries, and

Whereas, from the reports of the effectiveness of that program, and of its impact on the young interns, it appears to have accomplished the aims and purposes of the plan.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that in acknowledging the valuable assistance rendered by these youths employed in the E.E.A. - Section P.E.P. Employment Program, under the able direction of Roosevelt Benton, Administrative Aid to the Mayor, His Honor Mayor Joseph A. Doorley, Jr. joins the members of the City Council in praising not only their efforts but their comportment, which proves that the generation gap, so called is, to a great extent non-existent, when older mentors communicate with youth, on an intelligent level, and express confidence in the youth of this community.
