RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED:

That the following portion of named street as shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying Plan entitled, "Providence, R.I., P.W. Dept. - Engineering Office, Street Line Section, Plan No. 063963, dated March 23, 1976",

viz:

That the entire portion of Holyoke Street from the northerly line of Valley Street to the southerly line of Prescott Street (bounded by Lots 406 through 415 and Lots 117 through 119, 394, 396, 225 through 228 on Assessor's Plat 66) has ceased to be useful to the public and the same is proposed to be abandoned as a public highway, depicted on the above noted and accompanying plan as cross-hatched area, having ceased to be useful to the public and the same is proposed to be abandoned as a public highway and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, that the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, that after the entry of this order or decree, the City Clerk shall cause a notice, thereof, to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks, and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within this State.

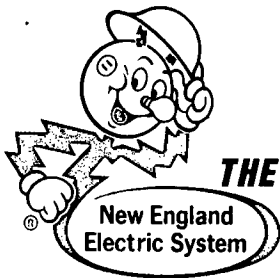



SUBJECT: Referral No. 1943 - HOLYOKE STREET (ABANDONMENT OF PORTION)

Gentlemen:

This petition from the Committee on Public Works proposes the abandonment of Holyoke St. from the northerly line of Valley St. to the southerly line of Prescott St. in Assessor's Plat 66.

Inspection revealed that Holyoke St. is not curbed or paved and does not exist as a public highway. The roadbed runs from the curb cuts on Valley St. for a distance of approximately 350 ft. and ends in a sheer embankment some 40+ ft. in height. There is a cement block one-story building approximately 146' x 90' located on Lots 410, 411, 412, 413 and 414, Assessor's Plat 66 on the east side of Holyoke St. The building has access on Catskill St., and the building owner is the petitioner. The petitioner is also owner of all other lots that front on Holyoke St.

The topography of Holyoke St. precludes the possibility of its ever being developed as a through street from Valley to Prescott Sts. Consequently, since the petitioner is the owner of all involved property, the street would serve no purpose as a public highway.

No objection is offered by this department to the granting of the petition.

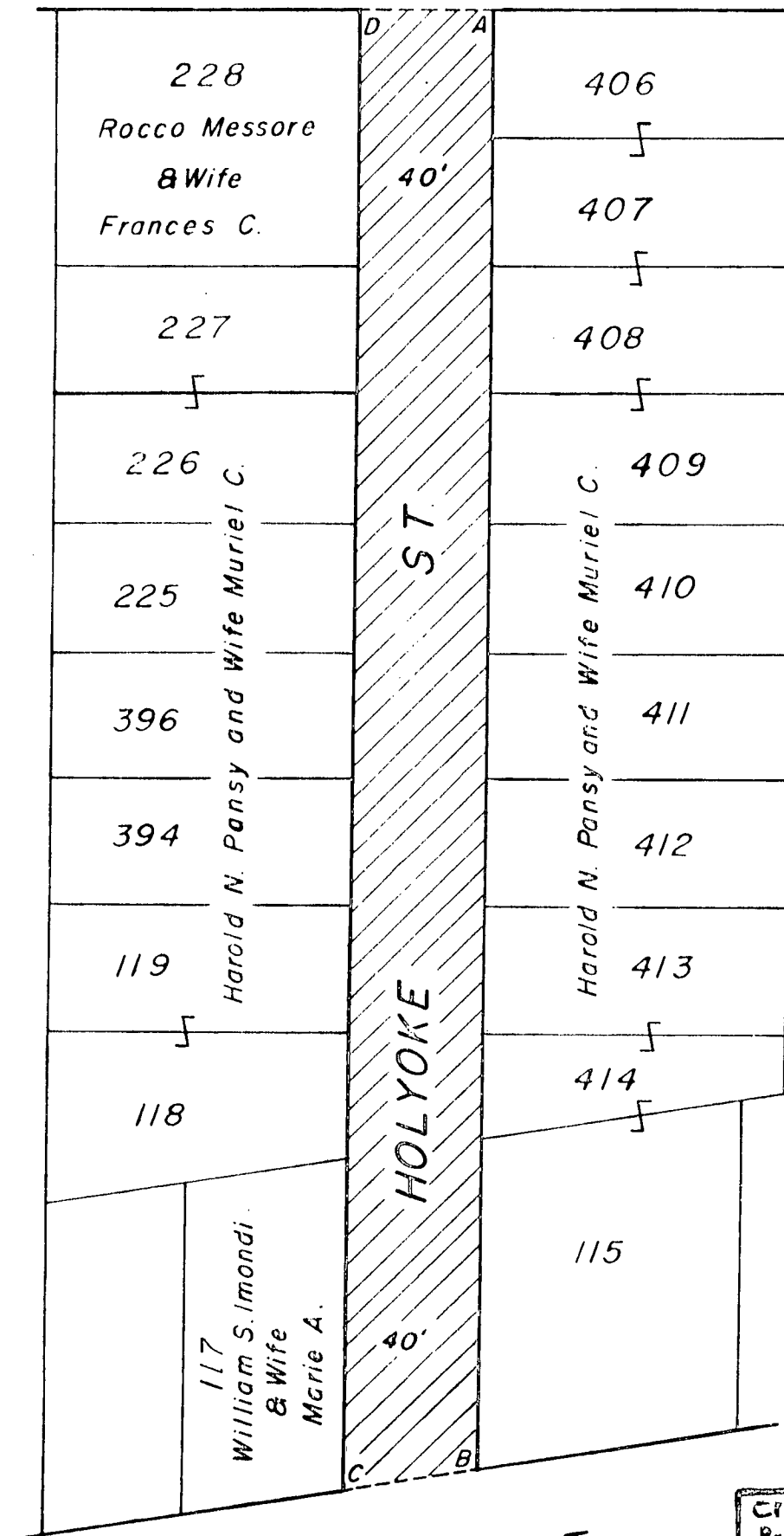
