



RE: TRANSMITTAL OF COMMUNICATION TO COMMITTEE

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REQUEST: That the Traffic Engineering is requested to cause the installation of four-way stop signs at the intesection of River Avenue and Pleasant Valley Parkway.

DISPOSITION: Denied. This intersection does not meet the requirements of a four way stop control. The apparent problem along River Avenue is speeding. Stop controls are not permitted to control speed. I will recommend in our 1996/1997 Budget requests to have a flashing beacon installed on River Avenue at Pleasant Valley Parkway stating the posted speed limit of 25 MPH.
