ELECTION OF CLERK OF PROBATE COURT

The City Council proceeds to Elect the Clerk of Probate Court in Accordance with the Provisions of Section XI of Chapter 3340 of the Public Laws of 1954, Approved April 26, 1954, Entitled, "An Act in Amendment of Clause I of Section XI of Chapter 598 of the Public Laws, 1866, as Amended, Relating to the Probate Court of the City of Providence."

JOHN L. McELROY, ESQUIRE, only nominee, was nominated to succeed himself for the term of Six (6) Years ending on the First Thursday in November, 1983, at the regular meeting of the City Council held on THURSDAY, OCTOBER 6, 1977, which date has allowed for the elapsed time of twenty days between the nomination and the election of the Clerk of Probate Court.

The nomination of JOHN L. McELROY, ESQUIRE, as Clerk of Probate Court is thereupon taken from the City Clerk's Desk on motion of COUNCILMAN LYNCH, seconded by COUNCILMAN ADDISON and FLYNN.

The City Council thereupon proceeds to elect JOHN L. McELROY, ESQUIRE only nominee, as Clerk of the Probate Court of the City of Providence.

On motion of COUNCILMAN LYNCH, seconded by COUNCILMEN ADDISON, AHERN, FLYNN and GLAVIN, it is voted to direct the Clerk to cast one ballot for JOHN L. McELROY, ESQUIRE, as Clerk of the Probate Court.

The Clerk casts one ballot for JOHN L. McELROY, ESQUIRE, as directed, for the ensuing term of Six (6) Years, ending on the First Thursday in November. 1983.

COUNCIL PRESIDENT HAXTON thereupon declares JOHN L. McELROY, ESQUIRE, duly elected as Clerk of the Probate Court of the City of Providence.
