RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 433

Approved June 20, 1983

WHEREAS, Raymond A. Lynch, former manager of the Dutchland Farms store on Messer Street, passed from this life on June 9, 1983, and

WHEREAS, He served in this position for twelve years, having previously served as proprietor of Lynch's Meatery in South Providence for twenty-five years, and

WHEREAS, The Dutchland Farm Company looked to his business acumen in naming him "Manager"; the neighborhood looked to his quick wit and abundant charm in naming him "Our host, Ray Lynch," and

WHEREAS, His knowledge and concern for the neighborhood and its residents and his unique ability to ingratiate himself to people of all age groups and ethnic backgrounds earned him the titled "Mayor of Messer Street",

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That this City Council does pause in its deliberations out of respect for the memory of Raymond A. Lynch, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That upon the adoption and approval of this Resolution the City Clerk is directed to cause copies of the same to be transmitted to the Lynch family and to the Dutchland Farms Store, that they be aware of the high esteem in which Raymond A. Lynch was held by the people he served.
