That the following portion named highway shown as crosshatched area on the accompanying Plan entitled "Providence, R. I., P. W. Dept. - Engineering Office, Street Line Section Plan No. 063930, Date: June 24, 1975,

Viz:

Washington Avenue, a portion of Washington Avenue, on City Assessor's Plat 56 from the Easterly Line of Michigan Avenue to the Termination Point of Washington Avenue, having ceased to be useful to the public and the same is abandoned as a public highway and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, that the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, that after the entry of this order or decree, the City Clerk shall cause a notice, thereof, to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks, and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within this State.





SUBJECT: REFERRAL NO. 1932 - ABANDONMENT PORTION WASHINGTON AVE.

Gentlemen:

This petition from the Providence City Council Committee on Public Works proposes the abandonment of that portion of Washington Ave. on Assessor's Plat 56 from the easterly line of Michigan Ave. running easterly to the termination point of Washington Ave. This section has a centerline length of approximately 390 ft. Said portion of Washington Ave. is abutted on each side by land owned by the petitioner (lots 286, 298, 301 and 302) who maintains that it is useless as a public right-of-way.

Inspection revealed that the portion of highway in question comes to a dead end on railroad property which has access via Shipyard St. and is fenced off at its point of abutment with Washington Ave. The section proposed for abandonment is not open to the public as a highway.


This department has no objection from a planning standpoint to the proposed abandonment.

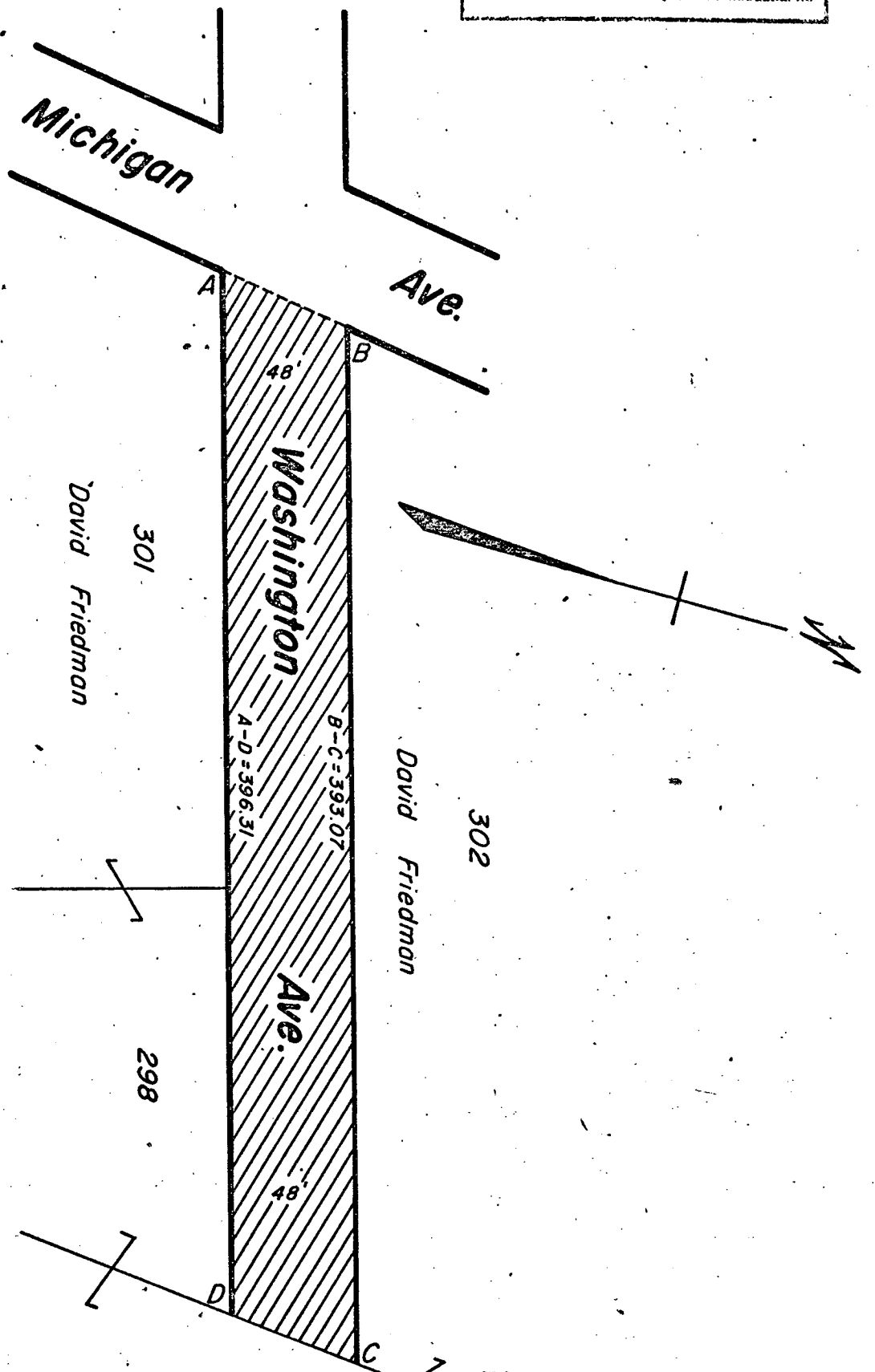





SECTION OF WASHINGTON AVE.

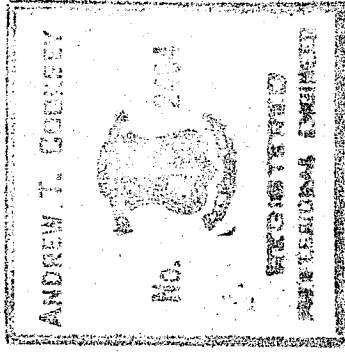
