MASON STREET (portion) from Aborn Street northerly along the easterly line a distance of (276.00') feet more or less, then across Mason Street to a point (252.00') feet more or less from the northerly intersection of Mason and Aborn Streets on the westerly line of Aborn Street.

having ceased to be useful to the public and the same are abandoned as public highways and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words "not a Public Highway," and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once each week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highways which have been abandoned, who is known to reside within this State.



We have received a memorandum dated October 2, 1970 from the Department of the City Clerk, together with a copy of a petition for abandonment of a portion of Aborn Street and a portion of Mason Street.

It has been the policy of the Water Supply Board not to bill the Redevelopment Agency for the depreciated value of our facilities in areas which they request abandonment.
