# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 798

Approved September 14, 1979

WHEREAS, In 1979, a program was instituted by the Chief of the Police Department to patrol Roger Williams Park, which had the endorsment of the Members of the City Council, and

WHEREAS, Roger Williams Park is used day and night by residents and non-residents of the City of Providence who do not have adequate Police protection when and if needed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Chief of the Police Department is hereby requested to order full time police patrol in Roger Williams Park for the protection of the Park and the citizens from vandalism and destruction and for the persons who jog, bicycle or stroll through the Park from physical and bodily harm, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That radio communications be provided via patrol cars in case of emergencies.
