Approved October 25, 1973

WHEREAS, the resumption of such armed conflict can bring nothing but loss of human lives and property to the Warring Nations in the Middle East,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that His Honor, Mayor Joseph A. Doorley, Jr., and the Members of the City Council do hereby express their profound sorrow at the resumption of this armed conflict, so-called, in the Middle East, and offer their fervent prayers that it be brought to an early cessation, to eliminate the unwanted slaughter of human lives and the devastation of the physical assets of all Nations that are engaged.
