## CHAPTER 1473

### No. 279 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING RELOCATION PAYMENTS.

Approved May 3, 1962

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1: The following definitions shall apply in the interpretation and enforcement of this Ordinance and any rules and regulations adopted pursuant thereto.

- 1) "Relocation payments" shall mean payments to transients, eligible individual or families and business concerns for their reasonable and necessary moving expenses and any actual direct losses of personal property to business concerns, except good will or profit, resulting from their displacement by any municipal project.
- 2) "Eligible individual or family" shall mean an individual or family owning furniture in housing accommodations.
- 3) "Individual" shall mean a person who is not a member of a family as defined below.
- 4) "Family" shall mean a group of two or more persons living together and related by blood, marriage or adoption; or two or more single persons not related by blood, marriage or adoption, who are living together in a single housekeeping unit.
- 5) "Transient" shall mean a displaced individual or family not owning furniture but occupying housing accommodations.
- 6) "Business concern" shall include a corporation, firm, partnership, individual, or other entity engaged in some type of business or profession necessitating fixtures, equipment, stock in trade, or other tangible property for the carrying on of the business or profession. Nonprofit organizations and institutions such as churches and hospitals are included.
- 7) "Occupied room" shall include all furnished rooms except bathrooms, hallways and closets.

SEC. 2. Upon presentation of satisfactory evidence of the fact of relocation, the Family and Business Relocation Service Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to make relocation payments to transients or eligible individuals, families and business concerns for moving expenses and property losses resulting from their displacement by any municipal project undertaken by the City after January 1, 1961.

SEC. 3. The sum of money to be paid to each individual, transient or family shall be in accordance with a schedule of payments adopted by the Administrator of Family and Business Relocation, and shall be based upon the number of occupied rooms. The sum to be paid to business concerns shall be based upon the actual necessary moving expenses incurred, and any direct losses sustained to personal property, but not goods kept for sale, good will or profit.

SEC. 4. All payments shall be made subject to rules and regulations prescribed by the aforesaid Administrator, and such payments and the rules and regulations shall at all times be subject to the approval of the Finance Director of the City of Providence. The payments shall not exceed TWO HUNDRED (\$200) DOLLARS in the case of each transient individual or family, or THREE THOUSAND (\$3,000) DOLLARS in the case of each business concern.

SEC. 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved May 3, 1962

Resolved,

**That** the City Council of the City of Providence hereby orders the assessment and collection of a tax on the ratable real estate and tangible personal property and ratable intangible personal property (the tax on ratable intangible property to be at the rate of forty cents on each one hundred dollars of the value thereof) in a sum not less than \$29,500,000 nor more than \$30,700,000; said tax is for ordinary expenses, charges and sinking funds, for the payment of interest and indebtedness in whole or in part of said City, and for other purposes authorized by law.

The City Assessor shall assess and apportion said tax on the inhabitants and ratable property of said City as of the 31st day of December, A. D. 1961, at twelve o'clock, noon, Eastern Standard Time according to law, and shall, on completion of said assessment, date and sign the same, and shall make out and certify to the City Collector of the City of Providence, on or before the 15th day of June, A. D. 1962, a complete list of the names of the persons taxed and of the total value of all the real estate taxed to each person, also the amount of personal estate assessed against each person, and also the total amount of the tax assessed against each person on said real estate and personal estate, opposite the name of the person or persons assessed, the assessment of real estate and of personal estate to appear in separate columns in said list. Said tax shall be due and payable on and between the 1st day of October, next and the twenty-fourth day of October, A. D. 1962, next, and all taxes remaining unpaid on said last named day shall carry until collected a penalty at the rate of eight percentum per annum upon such unpaid taxes. Provided, however, said tax may be paid in four installments, the first installment of twenty-five percentum on or before the twenty-fourth day of October, A. D. 1962, and the remaining in-

stallments as follows: Twenty-five percentum on the twenty-fourth day of January, A. D. 1963; Twenty-five per centum on the twenty-fourth day of April, A. D. 1963; and twenty-five percentum on the twenty-fourth day of July, A. D. 1963. Each installment of taxes, if paid on or before the last day of each installment period successively and in order, shall be free from any charge for interest. If the first installment or any succeeding installment of taxes is not paid by the last date of the respective installment period or periods as they occur, then the whole tax or remaining unpaid balance of the tax, as the case may be, shall immediately become due and payable and shall carry until collected a penalty at the rate of eight percentum per annum. The City Collector, shall by advertisement, in the public newspapers of the City, notify all persons assessed to pay their respective taxes at his office on and between the said 1st and twenty-fourth days of October, A. D. 1962, both days inclusive; said Collector shall attend daily during said periods, Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays excepted, at his office from nine o'clock A.M. to five o'clock P.M. to receive said taxes.






