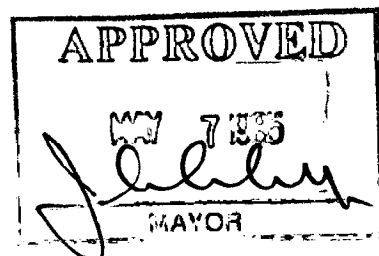

Dear Councilmen:

I respectfully request your assistance and cooperation to initiate the necessary action to have the city of Providence authorize the installation of a light at the site of the Trinity Gateway Project.

As you know this Providence Redevelopment Plan calls for landscaping of the main traffic islands in Trinity Square. As the project has developed over these many years we have now included the relocation of the Sergeant Henry E. Budd Memorial from its present location to one of more prominence on the main island. A flagpole will be erected and it is appropriate to provide illumination of the flag in order to display it continually.

A pole nearby which was recently erected as part of the traffic signalization work could provide for the necessary light. The Redevelopment Agency has advised us it is necessary to request this light directly from the city and not through the agency.

Therefore, the Elmwood Foundation, on behalf of all parties interested, requests your assistance to secure this lighting in conjunction with the completion of the project.
