## CHAPTER 1841

No. 856 **AN ORDINANCE** IN AMENDMENT OF AND IN ADDITION TO CHAPTER 1797 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE APPROVED NOVEMBER 7, 1966, AND ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE OFFICIAL REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE EAST SIDE PROJECT NO. R. I. R-4"

*Approved* April 11, 1967

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of November, 1966, the City Council of the City of Providence did adopt an ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance Approving and Adopting the Official Redevelopment Plan for the East Side Project No. R. I. R-4;" and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of the Department of Housing and Urban Development requests that a determination be made by the City of Providence as to whether or not the objectives of the Official Redevelopment Plan for the East Side Project No. R. I. R-4 can be achieved through extensive rehabilitation of the area encompassed within the bounds of the aforementioned Official Redevelopment Plan for the East Side Project No. R. I. R-4; and

WHEREAS, the Providence Redevelopment Agency has recommended that the aforementioned ordinance approving said Redevelopment Plan be modified to make the determination requested by the Secretary of the Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, the Providence Redevelopment Agency has not as yet acquired any property within the project boundaries in accordance with said Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

1. That the City Council of the City of Providence be and hereby determines that a public hearing on the Providence Redevelopment Agency's recommended modification to said ordinance is not necessary.

2. That the following paragraph be inserted between paragraph No. 13. and paragraph No. 14:

Page 2

13A. "That it is hereby found and determined that the objectives of the Official Redevelopment Plan for the East Side Project No. R. I. R-4 cannot be achieved through more extensive rehabilitation of the area described, referred to in and made a part of said Official Redevelopment Plan."

3. That this ordinance shall take effect on its passage and shall be filed with the City Clerk who is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy thereof to the Providence Redevelopment Agency.
