# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 390

Approved August 4, 1976

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the Office of One Councilman from the Twelfth Ward in the City of Providence, Rhode Island, caused by the death on July 21, 1976, of Francis Crowley, and

WHEREAS, the said vacancy did occur more than One Hundred Eighty Days before the time of the holding the next succeeding regular City Election, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3.4 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, known as the Providence Charter Act of 1940, as amended, and by Section 1 of Chapter 2864 of the Public Laws of 1951, approved May 1, 1951, it is mandatory that a Special Election for the purpose of filling such vacancy be held within ninety days of the date of the occurrence of such vacancy,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, that, in compliance with the provisions of the governing statutes, the said City Council does hereby order a Special Election to be held for the purpose of filling the vacancy in the Office of One Councilman from the Twelfth Ward of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, caused by the death on July 21, 1976, of Francis Crowley, said Special Election to be held on the first Tuesday, following the first Monday in October, 1976, being Tuesday, October 5, 1976, said date being within ninety days from the date of the occurrence of said vacancy, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Canvassers and Registration of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, and all other Officers whose duty it is to prepare for elections, are hereby requested and notified to make such preparations for said election as are required by law, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to cause a Certified Copy of this Resolution to be transmitted to the Board of Canvassers and Registration of the City of Providence, Rhode Island; and that a duly Certified Copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the State of Rhode Island Board of Elections and to the Secretary of State of Rhode Island.


