
Faces of the Rainforest

The goal of this unique project was to provide a new habitat for multiple animal and plant species indigenous to the South American Rainforest, in addition to bringing awareness to the impact of the rainforest upon our daily lives.


The interior of the exhibit was designed at different elevations to create a cascading effect that exists naturally in this environment and includes 2 bridges for patrons to enjoy as they look over the multiple waterfalls. The path that meanders through the sunken forest includes over 100 different tropical plant species, several species of primates and over a dozen different types of birds that have free range of the space. Additional adjacent animal exhibits include the large primate enclosure, giant river otter tank and anaconda habitat.

The components used in the main building had to withstand the design criteria of 75 degrees and 75% humidity year-round in the harsh New England environment. All structural steel was color galvanized to prevent corrosion and remain aesthetically pleasing, in addition to all materials used were non-porous and easily cleanable to keep exhibit hygienic.

Despite obstacles and challenges, Bentley completed the project and exceeded expectations while ensuring the safety of all humans, animals and creating a sustainable, thriving habitat.





This two-phased project included creating a temporary barricade and extensive civil work to remove an exterior wall and expand the school's antiquated fitness area to create 3,000 sf of state-of-the-art training spaces and locker rooms for student athletes.

The subsequent phase required rework of existing classrooms and training rooms to create two large locker rooms (both male and female) along with a revitalized trainers office allowing staff to best service students.







STATE OF RI - PORTSMOUTH Department of Transportation Facility



Bentley received the award to renovate the Rhode Island Department of Transportation Maintenance facility, located in Portsmouth, RI in December of 2015. This facility required extensive work and collaboration to ensure that specific state requirements and requests were met.


The structure itself was dismantled to the frame in order to insulate and waterproof the foundation to meet current standards. The existing framework was reinforced with structural steel and new overhead doors were installed to allow the massive equipment to enter the facility for maintenance.

To optimize moisture protection for the building, new roofing and spray insulation were installed. A new mezzanine space was added in the maintenance facility, along with vehicle lifts, de-icing brine tanks, fueling stations to receive, store and deliver, as well as hose lube stations.

The entrance was designed to accommodate fuel delivery tank trucks for delivery and turnaround, while not blocking flow of traffic. Fuel transfer takes place with on-site hoses into the storage tanks. These storage tanks were designed at a lower elevation to allow for fuel transfer by gravity, eliminating the need for pumps. All fuel was filtered prior to entering the storage tank to prevent contamination. The storage tanks were fitted with pumps to allow for transfer of fuel to refueling trucks.

The storm drainage systems and water service systems were updated, along with HVAC, fire alarm, plumbing & electrical systems. Oil-water separators were added in the event of any spills.

To optimize space, the entire parking lot was excavated to allow for new asphalt and curbing. Additionally, new permanent fencing and landscaping were installed.
