No. 52 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF ONE

MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$1,500,000) DOLLAR PUBLIC WELFARE BUILDING BONDS, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 160 OF THE PUBLIC LAWS OF 1965.

Approved April 9, 1968

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. The sum of ONE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$1,500,000) DOLLARS shall be borrowed and shall be used for the construction and equipping of a public welfare administration building, including the acquisition of land for such purpose. The City Treasurer, with the approval of the Mayor and the Committee on Finance, is authorized to issue ONE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$1,500,000) DOLLAR Public Welfare Building Bonds, pursuant to Chapter 160 of the Public Laws of 1965 and, subject to the foregoing, to determine the denominations, interest rate or rates, and other terms, conditions and details of the bonds in accordance with law.

SEC. 2. The bonds shall be issued originally as coupon bonds in substantially the form approved by the City Council in Resolution No. 63, approved February 21, 1968. The bonds shall be sold at public sale at not less than par and accrued interest and shall bear such date or dates as the City Council shall determine by resolution and shall be payable in annual installments commencing not later than five (5) years and ending not later than twenty-five (25) years from their date or dates as the City Council shall determine by resolution.

SEC. 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all other ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

No. 53 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF

SIX MILLION (\$6,000,000) DOLLAR SCHOOL BONDS PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 185 OF THE PUBLIC LAWS OF 1962.

Approved April 9, 1968

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. The sum of SIX MILLION (\$6,000,000) DOLLARS shall be borrowed and shall be used for the purchase of land for public school purposes and for the construction, furnishing and equipping of public school buildings. The City Treasurer, with the approval of the Mayor and the Committee on Finance, is authorized to issue SIX MILLION (\$6,000,000) DOLLAR School Bonds, pursuant to Chapter 185 of the Public Laws of 1962 and, subject to the foregoing, to determine the denominations, interest rate or rates, and other terms, conditions and details of the bonds in accordance with law.

SEC. 2. The bonds shall be issued originally as coupon bonds in substantially the form approved by the City Council in Resolution No. 63, approved February 21, 1968. The bonds shall be sold at public sale at not less than par and accrued interest and shall bear such date or dates as the City Council shall determine by resolution and shall be payable in annual installments commencing not later than five (5) years and ending not later than twenty-five (25) years from their date or dates as the City Council shall determine by resolution.

SEC. 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all other ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

No. 54 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$500,000) DOLLAR SCHOOL ATHLETIC FIELDS BONDS PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 1898 OF THE PUBLIC LAWS OF 1947 AS AMENDED.

Approved April 9, 1968

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. The sum of FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$500,000) DOLLARS shall be borrowed and shall be used for acquiring, developing and improving school athletic fields, including the purchase or condemnation of land for such purposes. The City Treasurer, with the approval of the Mayor and the Committee on Finance, is authorized to issue FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$500,000) DOLLAR School Athletic Fields Bonds pursuant to Chapter 1898 of the Public Laws of 1947 as amended by Chapter 166 of the Public Laws of 1962 and Chapter 106 of the Public Laws of 1963 and, subject to the foregoing, to determine the denominations, interest rate or rates, and other terms, conditions and details of the bonds in accordance with law.

SEC. 2. The bonds shall be issued originally as coupon bonds in substantially the form approved by the City Council in Resolution No. 63, approved February 21, 1968. The bonds shall be sold at public sale at not less than par and accrued interest and shall bear such date as the City Council shall determine by resolution and shall be payable in annual installments commencing five years from their date as follows: THIRTY THOUSAND (\$30,000) DOLLARS in each year from the first to the tenth year, both inclusive and TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND (\$25,000) DOLLARS in the eleventh to the eighteenth year, both inclusive.

SEC. 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all other ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
