

RE: DUNNIGAN PARK, AKA VALLEY STREET PARK (across from Caruso's)

This park is in a tough area. It is cleaned weekly and mowed on a once/10 day schedule.

The basketball court is in decrepit condition. It is one we got from Recreation 4 years ago and no money has been put into the court besides replacing nets. There is grass growing up through the court because the asphalt has cracked.

This is a good example of how some of the CD dollars going to DPW for road resurfacing could be spent. The court is about 50' x 100'. With 3 inches of asphalt from DPW and with new court lines from Parks, we could have a new court for very little money.

Could you ask the Mayor to set aside enough DPW road resurfacing money to do 5 - 10 courts? Make it seem like it is his idea. It is a cheap way to get recreational improvements in many areas of the city.
