

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 74

Approved February 14, 1974

RESOLVED, that the City Treasurer, acting under the direction of the Committee on Finance, be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to borrow from time to time such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding SIX MILLION, FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$6,500,000) DOLLARS, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 79 of the Public Laws, passed by the General Assembly at its January Session, A.D. 1971, and approved November 7, 1972, entitled "An Act Authorizing the City of Providence to Issue Bonds in the Amount of Six Million, Five Hundred Thousand (\$6,500,000) Dollars for the Repairing of the Existing Seawall at Fields Point and Constructing an Extension Thereof and for Constructing Additional Docking and Support Facilities," and to issue the City's notes therefor, signed by him and countersigned by the Mayor and Chairman of the Finance Committee; and to renew any such notes from time to time as the same become due. The money thus obtained is hereby appropriated for and shall be expended for the construction and extension of docking and support facilities in the City of Providence.
