In accordance with the provisions of Section 406 of the Providence Home Rule Charter of 1980, I, the undersigned hereby respectfully request you call a Special Meeting of the City Council on Friday, the 29th Day of June, 1990, at 7:30 o'clock P.M. (EDT).

The purpose of said meeting is for the City Council to consider the following matters, viz;

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 15-2 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE ENTITLED: "PENALTIES FOR TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS".

AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF SEC. 17-28 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE ENTITLED: "ASSIGNMENT OF POLICE OFFICERS TO CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS".

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION C OF CHAPTER 1342, APPROVED AUGUST 5, 1960, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 544 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, APPROVED SEPTEMBER 21, 1951, AS AMENDED, BY ADDING ARTICLE VI-A, ENTITLED: 'HISTORIC DISTRICT ZONING', CREATING THE HISTORIC ARMORY DISTRICT IN ADDITION TO THE HISTORIC COLLEGE HILL DISTRICT, THE HISTORIC STIMSON AVENUE DISTRICT AND THE HISTORIC BROADWAY DISTRICT, AS AMENDED".


