Pursuant to Section 3.11 of the Providence City Charter, I am this day requesting a Special Meeting of the City Council to be held on Monday, July 6, 1981 at 8:00 P.M. EDT, for the purpose of considering the following:

- A. An Ordinance making an Appropriation for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 1982
- B. An Ordinance establishing the classes of positions, the maximum number of employees and the number of employees in certain classes in the City Departments and repealing Chapter 1981-12, effective March 23, 1981, as amended.
- C. An Ordinance establishing a compensation plan for the City of Providence and repealing Chapter 1981-13, effective March 23, 1981.
- D. An Ordinance providing for the assessment and collection of 1981 taxes in a sum not less than Eighty-Seven Million Dollars (87,000,000) and not more than Ninety- Nine Million Dollars (99,000,000) being based on One Hundred Per Cent (100%) of the 1981-1982 Fiscal Year Tax Collection.
