# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 105

Approved March 7, 1980

WHEREAS, The So-Called Valley View Housing Complex was established and constructed for the purpose of housing Veterans returning from service in World War II, and

WHEREAS, The So-Called Valley View Housing Complex is no longer used for the purpose of housing Veterans returning from service in World War II and has fulfilled said purposes, and

WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the City of Providence that the So-Called Valley View Housing Complex remain a viable housing resource for the use and enjoyment of the Citizens of the City of Providence,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That His Honor the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute such deeds and other documents to convey the So-Called Valley View Housing Complex to the Providence Housing Authority upon approval of the application of said Authority to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for funding to purchase and rehabilitate the So-Called Valley View Housing Complex, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That such deeds and other documents conveying the So-Called Valley View Housing Complex to the Providence Housing Authority shall be executed only upon the issuance of a waiver from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development which shall allow the elimination of the initial low-rent public housing occupancy income limits for all current residents of the So-Called Valley View Housing Complex, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That such deeds and other documents conveying the So-Called Valley View Housing Complex to the Providence Housing Authority shall be executed only upon the issuance of a waiver from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development which shall allow the elimination of initial low-rent public housing occupancy income limits for all future residents of the So-Called Valley View Housing Complex so as to provide for continuity of the current mixed income residential population within said Housing Complex.


