This resolution renamed Mancini Drive to Buttonhole Drive. We appreciate your office's assistance with changing the name, but unfortunately Buttonhole was spelled as one word when it is actually two words, Button Hole. The post office brought this to our attention. Apparently the resolution went directly to the post office and was entered into their scanning system database program, thus creating some confusion and undeliverable mail. Post office personnel suggested contacting you to request the slight modification.

A recent call to your office prompted this letter. Hopefully this issue can be addressed at an upcoming City Council meeting. Your assistance with changing "Buttonhole Drive" to "Button Hole Drive" is greatly appreciated. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.

The Button Hole Short Course & Teaching Center is a non-profit organization that makes golf and the lessons taught by golf affordable and accessible for local youth. This year over 1,000 local youth will participate in instructional programs covering the rules, etiquette, swing mechanics and social aspects of golf. Locally children from the Olneyville Boys & Girls Club, Providence Police Department, Providence Recreation Department, O.H. Perry Middle School and Providence Housing Authority Communities are enjoying this beautifully transformed 26-acre facility.

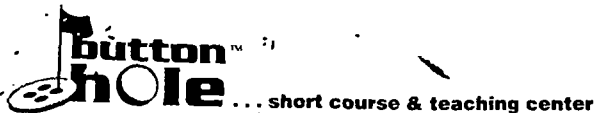
