ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the City of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within the State.







Disposition: No objection to said abandonment.


Request: That lots 23, 25, 26, 27 and 28 on City Assessor's Plat 66, located along Prescott Street be abandoned.

Gentlemen:

The subject petition from the Providence City Council Committee on Public Works proposes the abandonment of Coleridge Court from Federal Street to its southerly termination. The petition was submitted by William Ciccone at 54 Federal Street, Providence, Rhode Island.

A field inspection revealed that Coleridge Court is paved with asphalt and is now being used as an entrance to the parking lots at Coleridge Court. The petitioner owns the parking lot at the westerly side of Coleridge Court.

Coleridge Court is a dead-end street and is located within the Federal Hill East Renewal Project. The neighborhood is in fair condition. There is a question whether or not the vehicle accessibility to serve the building which is located at the end of Coleridge Court is adequate, if this street is abandoned. Therefore,

To members of the City Council:

What is the real reason for abandoning Coleridge Court?

For over 65 years, Coleridge Court served the:

Smith Estate, which consisted of 3 houses, 4 families,
1 building with 3 stores and 1 family on the second floor;

Russillo Estate, 1 house, 2 families and 1 garage;

Williamson Estate, 6 apartments and large store.

Coleridge Court was the only rear entrance for Delivery Trucks (making deliveries of all types); also, Tenants had access to get in and out with their vehicles.

These properties were purchased and demolished for a 3 Story Building housing 14 Business firms, plus a parking area for 36 cars.

Each day Coleridge Court is used by large Trailer Trucks and Small Trucks, which back up to the platform of the building to deliver and pick up merchandise from the business firms occupying said building.

Since the completion of said building, we were told to maintain this Coleridge Court, which would be used as a driveway to the building. Narragansett Improvement (Mr. Black) paved this driveway at the cost of \$2800. Since then, each year we have been responsible for the removal of snow and clearing debris of broken bottles and rubbish.

This Coleridge Court has been the Main driveway since its existence for over 65 years.

Doorley Vetoes Council Action

Mayor Joseph A. Doorley Jr. sent to the Providence City Council last night his veto of a resolution approved two weeks ago that ordered the abandonment as a public highway of Coleridge Court.

The veto, an infrequent occurrence under the city's Democratic administration, was only the second in nearly three years.

Mr. Doorley said he was disapproving the measure only because an abutting property owner had not received proper legal notice of the abandonment petition and consequently missed an opportunity to oppose it at a public works committee hearing.
