

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 389

Approved May 27, 2003

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, That His Honor, the Mayor, is authorized to grant a utility easement on property owned by the Providence Water Supply Board (Providence Water) located in the City of Cranston, to enable the Narragansett Electric Company (Narragansett) to provide electrical service to a Providence Water facility. Said easement shall be granted specifically upon the following provisions:


1. Said easement shall be utilized only for the installation, maintenance and repair of an electrical service of approximately 1,000 feet long, over a portion of Providence Water property in Western Cranston, Rhode Island, to serve a Providence Water facility.


2. Said easement shall be deemed to run with the land and shall operate against any successors in title and the easement or a memorandum of same shall be recorded in the Office of Land Records for the City of Cranston.

3. Said easement shall be subject to a right of reverter/right of reversion in the event that the situs of the easement is no longer utilized for the aforesated purposes.

4. The costs of all future maintenance and repair of the electrical service for which the grant of the easement is required will be borne by Narragansett.

5. Such other terms and conditions as may be reflected in the record and minutes of the City Council Committee on City Property and/or as may be deemed appropriate by the Mayor or the Department of Law.





## MEMORANDUM

**TO:** PROVIDENCE WATER SUPPLY BOARD

**FROM:** Paul J. Gadoury, P.E., Director of Engineering 

**DATE:** October 8, 2002

**RE:** Request for a utility easement across a portion of Providence Water land in Cranston

### Purpose

For the Board of the Providence Water Supply to grant a utility easement to the Narragansett Electric Company across a portion of Providence Water property in Western Cranston.

### Analysis

The scope of work for the Rehabilitation of our 90" Aqueduct and Tunnel project requires that we install a new access structure into our 90" aqueduct on Providence Water property. This new structure requires that an approximate 1,000 foot long electrical service be run across our property to the new structure to power various lighting and security equipment. In order to complete the electrical service installation across our property, an easement agreement allowing Narragansett Electric Company future access to the property for maintenance and repair of the electrical line is necessary. The exact location of the line will be field determined at the time of installation. The easement rights intended to be conveyed by this agreement consist of allowing Narragansett Electric access to any portion of the property as necessary for the purposes of future maintenance and repair of the line. Our Engineering Dept. has reviewed this proposed easement agreement and does not find it to pose any potential problems from an operations, maintenance, or water quality standpoint, and finds that granting this easement is in the best interest of Providence Water.

A sketch showing the location of the Providence Water property to which access will be granted under this agreement is attached.

**Financial Impact**

Granting of this easement will result in the future maintenance and repair of this electrical line and all costs thereof being the responsibility of Narragansett Electric Company. Without the easement, ownership, maintenance and repair of the line would be Providence Water's responsibility.

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Board approve the granting of the new utility easement and authorize the General Manager to process the easement through the City Council and City Properties Committee of the City of Providence, and authorize the necessary recordings.

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

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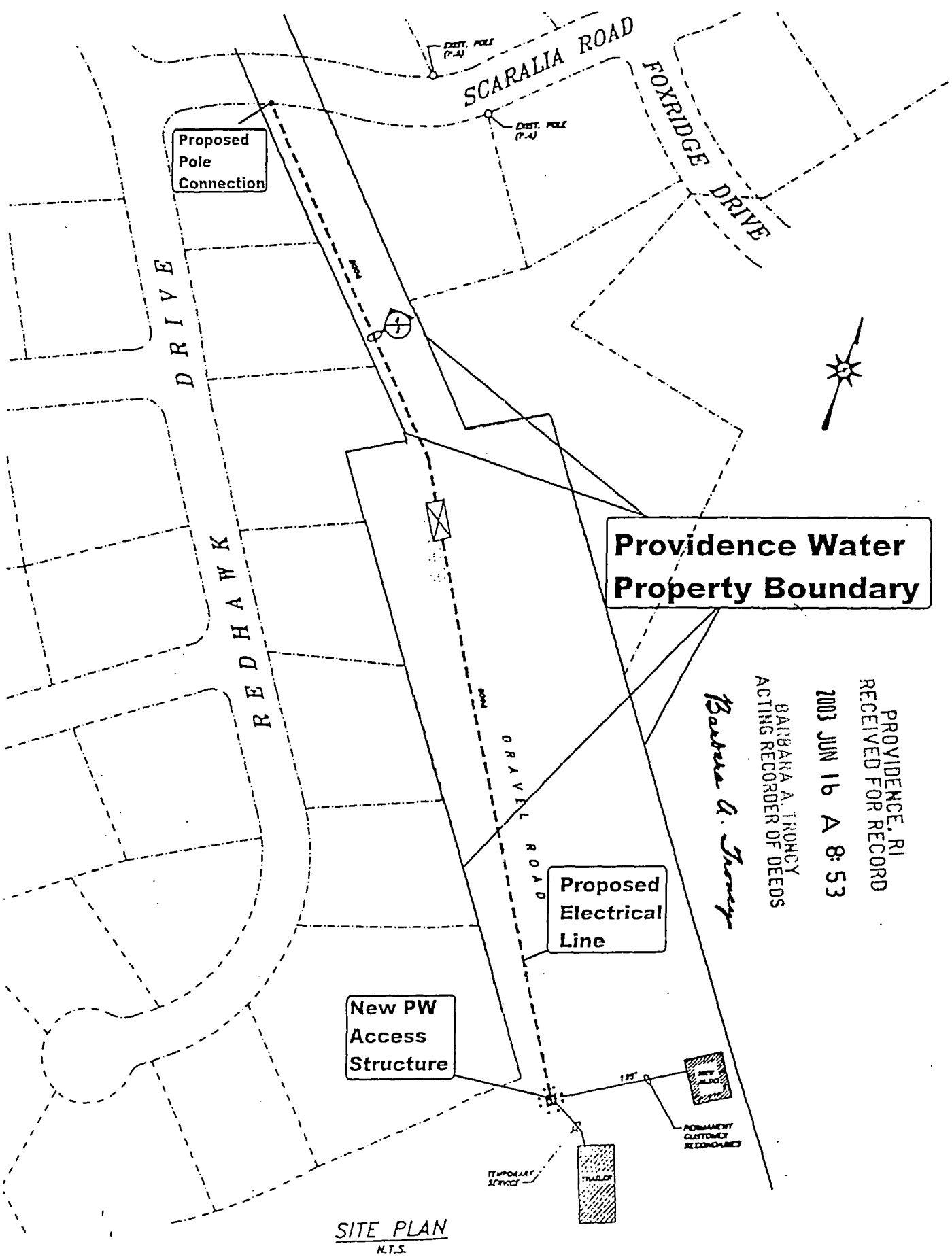
