**No. 560 AN ORDINANCE** Establishing the Classes of Position, the Maximum Number of Employees and the Number of Employees in Certain Classes in the Water Supply Board and Repealing Ordinance Chapter 1982 -13, approved March 26, 1982, as amended.

### *Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*
