WHEREAS, She holds a degree in history and is now currently a student of Historic Preservation at Roger Williams College, and

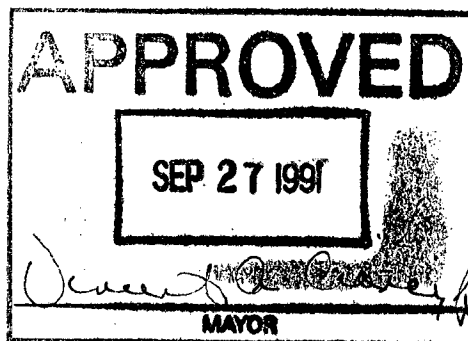

greatly appreciated.



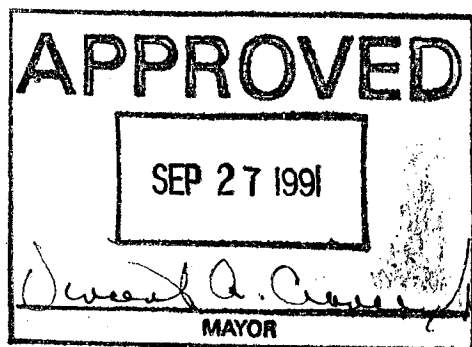
